



Weekend Closures to Affect Desmond Bridge Lanes, Connector Full shutdown Sunday of transition from south I-710

October 25, 2012

The connector from the southbound I-710 Freeway to the westbound Gerald Desmond Bridge/Ocean Boulevard will be closed from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday, October 28, for restriping of lanes.

Meanwhile, on the bridge, one lane in each direction will be closed from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Saturday, October 27. And on Sunday, October 28, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., one eastbound lane will be closed, with all westbound lanes open. The Los Angeles County Department of Public Works will be performing bridge repairs.

The 710 connector restriping project had been scheduled for the previous Sunday, but was postponed due to weather. During this weekend's closure, motorists will be redirected by signs to go around the closure by exiting the freeway at Pico Avenue, then getting back on the Ocean/Desmond Bridge ramp.
