Closure to Ramp from Pier T to Westbound Ocean Boulevard Detour could start Feb. 20, continue up to nine weeks

Feb. 15, 2013

A temporary closure to the connector from Pier T Avenue to Westbound Ocean Boulevard starting as soon as Wednesday, Feb. 20, will require motorists trying to head west from Pier T to take a detour. The closure will continue for up to nine weeks.

Cars and trucks that need to head west toward the 47 Freeway or San Pedro from Pier T must first take the ramp to the eastbound Gerald Desmond Bridge. Motorists have two detour choices:

- Exit the eastbound Gerald Desmond Bridge at Pico Avenue. Turn right (north) onto Pico Avenue and then turn left (west) to the on-ramp to the westbound Gerald Desmond Bridge.
- From the eastbound Gerald Desmond Bridge, take the transition to the 710 Freeway north, and continue to exits from westbound Anaheim Street or westbound Pacific Coast Highway to again head west toward your destination.
