



Meetings Set July 25 for W. Anaheim Street Improvement Project

Roadway reconstruction to start in August

July 19, 2013

The Port of Long Beach will host two informational meetings on Thursday, July 25, on an upcoming project to renovate West Anaheim Street from the Los Angeles River to the western City of Long Beach limits. The roadway improvement project is badly needed due to the poor condition of the existing pavement.

The project will take a phased approach that allows for continued traffic flow -- two lanes in each direction -- and access to businesses throughout construction.

Construction is scheduled to begin in mid-August and will take about 14 months to complete. The project also includes improvements for sidewalks, bus stops, access for the disabled and landscaping.
