



Ramp Closure Set for Queensway Bridge Exit

Repaving work also to close lane on southbound Harbor Scenic Drive

Sept. 5, 2013

An exit ramp from southbound Queensway Bridge to the northbound 710 Freeway/Queensway Drive will be temporarily closed for repaving starting Monday, Sept. 9, through Sept. 16.

Motorists will be directed to a detour via Harbor Plaza to reach the waterfront hotels and restaurants along Queensway Drive. [See a detour map.](#) While heading southbound on the bridge, the detour will direct motorists to head to "The Port of Long Beach" and then "Harbor Plaza East." Once on Harbor Plaza East, the detour continues to Queensway Drive, which is the access road to the waterfront businesses.



At the same time, there will be a lane closure on southbound 710 Freeway/Harbor Scenic Drive due to repaving and temporary closure of the Harbor Plaza West exit from the 710/Harbor Scenic. Motorists trying to reach the Port Administration Building or nearby sites can take the exit before — "Piers F, G West Pico Ave" — or the exit after — "Harbor Plaza East."

Both closures will take no longer than seven days. The same sites will be affected about two weeks later for one day of restriping of lines.

The Port of Long Beach is committed to keeping Harbor District roadways


maintained in good condition and to minimizing impacts of construction on motorists and businesses.
