# Harbor Plaza Closed October 2-5 for Green Port Fest

**ITS and PCT still open for business, reachable via Harbor Scenic Drive**

The annual Green Port Fest returns this weekend and takes to the street block-party-style, closing down the stretch of Harbor Plaza near the Port Administration Building from Thursday, October 2, through Sunday, October 5.

The Green Port Fest event itself is on Saturday, October 4, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. of course, with a full day of boat tours, train rides and interactive exhibits that explain Port operations. Thousands of residents are expected to come to the Port – parking is free at the Queen Mary – to enjoy the festivities. It's the best way to see the Port and to learn about the environmental protections and security measures under way at the harbor.

In order to set up, hold and tear down the event, the Port must close down Harbor Plaza between Pico Avenue and Harbor Scenic Drive.

Businesses, drayage drivers and others should be aware that the International Transportation Service facility on Pier G and Pacific Container Terminal on Pier J will remain open during the period that Harbor Plaza is closed for Green Port Fest. They should take the 710 Freeway to Harbor Scenic Drive to access ITS and PCT.
