



## **Closures Set for Pico Ramps to and from Eastbound Ocean Blvd. September 9-10 is first shutdown needed for road-repair project**

A repaving project near Pier E at the Port of Long Beach will require closing access between Pico Avenue and eastbound Ocean Boulevard at least three times in September. The first is set for 9 a.m. Friday, September 9 to 6 p.m. Saturday, September 10.

The closures are planned for the Pico off-ramp from eastbound Ocean and the on-ramp to eastbound Ocean from Pico in the Port of Long Beach.

The second closure is tentatively set for 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tuesday September 13.

The third closure, for restriping, has not yet been scheduled.

The Port is funding the \$200,000 resurfacing project. The Port of Long Beach is committed to keeping Harbor District roadways maintained in good condition and to minimizing the impacts of construction on motorists.
